

WHAT IS SERVICE LEARNING?

SERVICE LEARNING is a form of "hands on" learning that combines service to the community with classroom learning. It has four components: Academics; Service to the Community; Reflection of Service; and Civic Engagement and Responsibility. Non-profit organizations, governmental agencies, and educational facilities cooperate with students and faculty to engage the student in a service learning placement that coincides with the material being learned in the class.
