Completion time is based on taking 12 credits per semester, fall and spring semesters only.

This program will cost in-district residents \$4,096 if completed within normal time. It will cost out-of-state residents \$7,071.

These costs include tuition, required fees, any additional required course fees, and any book and supply costs. Any courses taken online will have an additional \$25 per credit hour charge. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs used the Fall 2019 posted tuition and fee rates (see <http://uar.nmsu.edu/tuition-rates/>) and were accurate at the time of posting, but may have changed.
