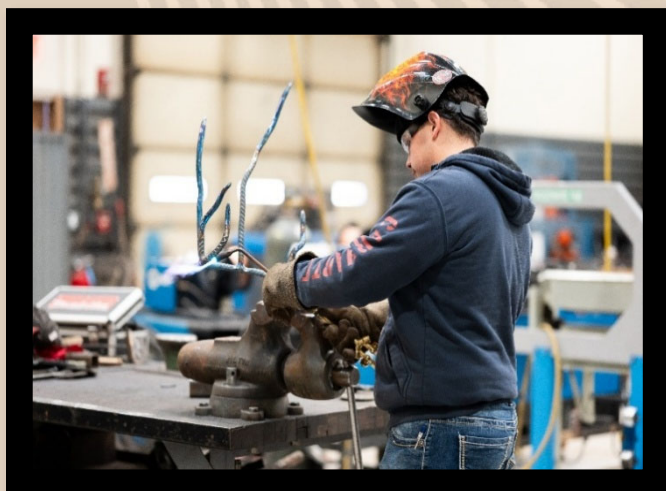

New Student Check List

1: Apply for Admissions and Financial Aid

- Submit your Admissions Application at admissions.nmsu.edu/apply/ Be sure to select "Grants" as your campus. Expect 2-3 days for your application to be processed.
- Have official GED, high school, and/or college transcripts sent to gradmissions@nmsu.edu or mailed to NMSU Grants, 1500 N. 3rd St., Grants, NM, 87020. All GED transcripts must be ordered via Diploma Sender at www.diplomasender.com. Students who have not submitted their transcripts will not be able to register beyond their first semester.
- Apply for federal financial aid (Pell grants, loan, & work study) at www.FAFSA.gov
- Scholar Dollar is a single application that connects students to all scholarships offered at NMSU. Apply for scholarships with Scholar Dollar <https://scholarships.nmsu.edu>.

2: Get Ready to Register

- All students must be placed into English and Mathematics. Placement can be done via the Accuplacer Test, SAT or ACT, or previous coursework. If you choose not to be placed, you will start with the lowest level of remedial coursework in that subject. Contact the Student Success Center at 505-287-6691 for more information or to schedule your Accuplacer test.
- Go to myaccount.nmsu.edu/activation and activate your student account. This will be your username and password for your NMSU accounts, including email and CANVAS. For account assistance contact Information Technology at 505-287-6666, or the ICT Help desk at help@nmsu.edu or Zoom Meeting ID: icthelpdesk
- New students to the Grants Campus must attend New Student Orientation. Students must complete orientation before they will be allowed to register for classes. Contact Student Services at 505-287-6678 to be added to the Orientation course.

3: Register for Classes and Pay

- Schedule an advising appointment at nmsu.campus.eab.com through the Navigate Student App, or call 505-287-6678. Your advisor will help new students select and register for their courses.

- Purchase your textbooks by going to bkstr.com/nmsustore. Select "Textbooks" on the top menu bar, and be sure to select the correct campus for the course.

Tuition & Fees

By enrolling in classes at New Mexico State University (NMSU), a student makes a financial commitment to pay the tuition and fee charges associated with that enrollment.

Registration is considered completed once a student has registered for a course(s). If a student chooses not to attend NMSU for a term, she/he must officially withdraw from NMSU for that specific term. For more information, visit: <https://uar.nmsu.edu/>

A withdrawal form must be completed with Student Services to withdraw from a course or from the University. Not following this procedure may result in "F's" for all courses for which you are registered. Students withdrawing after the stated refund dates remain liable for full tuition and fee charges.

Senior Citizen Reduced Tuition Program

On a space-available basis, seniors (65+) may enroll for up to 10 credits at \$5 per credit, non-degree seeking status. State law requires that senior citizens taking more than 10 credit hours be charged full rate for all credits based on in-district or out-of-district residency. **All other fees are charged at full rate (Course Delivery Fees, Course Fees, and other additional fees as applicable). Complete the application in the Student Services Office. For more information, go to: records.nmsu.edu**

- **Option 1:** Senior citizen students may register on the **first day of class** and be assessed the \$5.00 per credit hour tuition plus any applicable course fees.
- **Option 2:** Senior citizen students may register **prior to the first day of class** and be assessed the full NMSU tuition (\$89 per credit in-district/\$99 out of district) plus any applicable course fees.

Community Education Option

The Community Education Option allows individuals to participate in a credit course similar to a typical noncredit community education course. Individuals do not have to apply for official admission and enrollment to NMSU Grants. No official college transcript is produced nor grade awarded. Individuals enrolled under the Community Education Option are required to follow university policy and are bound by the NMSU Grants Student Code of Conduct as are all other individuals authorized to use university services and facilities. Please call (505) 287-6678 for more information. **Senior citizen reduced tuition does not apply to community education option.**

Refund of Tuition and Fees for Summer 2026

Students officially withdrawing or dropping courses during the Summer 2026 semester are eligible to receive a refund as follows:

1 st 8 Weeks (May 20-July 13) -- Through June 1.....	100%
10 Week (May 27 – August 6) – Through June 9.....	100%
1 st 5 Weeks (May 27 – June 30) – Through June 2.....	100%
2 nd 8 Weeks (June 16-August 6) – Through June 26....	100%
2 nd 5 Weeks (July 1-August 6) -- Through July 8.....	100%

Refund of Tuition and Fees for Fall 2026

Students officially withdrawing or dropping courses during the Fall 2026 semester are eligible to receive a refund as follows:

16 Week (August 19-December 11)- Through September 4.....	100%
8 Week I (August 19-October 11)- Through August 28.....	100%
8 Week II (October 12-December 11)- Through October 21	100%

Payment Plan

Paying for a college education is one of the first major financial decisions a student will make. The payment plan has scheduled payment installments designed to help a student manage the costs and pay balances by the end of the semester.

- Students are encouraged to enroll in the payment plan when the **current semester** outstanding balance is **\$200 or more**.
- Each payment plan is semester-specific.
- Payment plans are only **available** to students **enrolled in the current semester**.

To avoid the \$25 Payment Plan Application Fee and the late fees, enroll in the Payment Plans by the enrollment deadline dates.

- The payment plan **enrollment dates will be posted 100% ONLINE at uar.nmsu.edu**
- The **deadline to enroll** in the payment plan is posted 100% ONLINE at uar.nmsu.edu
- There will be a **non-refundable, \$25 application fee***

***Please note that the \$25.00 Payment Plan Application Fee and late fees will be waived if you enroll in the Payment Plan by the deadline dates.**

- **Fall and Spring** semester payment plans will have **five payments** and the **Summer** semester plan will have **three payments**.
- The **remaining payments** will be **due by the 15th of each month**.
- There will be a **\$10 fee charged*** to a student's account **for each late, partial, or missed payment**.
 - Payment amounts are subject to change if any charges or credits post **after** enrolling in the Payment Plan.
 - A student **cannot** have a **prior semester** balance of **\$600 or more**.

Federal Financial Aid

Students should complete any requirements to receive financial aid as soon as possible to ensure awarded funds are available to use toward their financial charges.

- Students who have not completed their financial aid arrangements in time to receive their awards by the due date **MAY** need to enroll in a payment plan.
